- Have a conversation with participants ahead of time to talk about local laws, guidelines, and emergency protocol

- Physical assault
- Disappearance or kidnapping of a student
- Robbery
- Sexual assault or rape
- Serious illness, physical or emotional
- Significant accident and/or injury
- Hospitalization for any reason
- Terrorist threat or attack
- Local political crisis that could affect the students' safety and well being
- Arrests or questioning by police or other security forces
- Any legal action involving a student
