Dear Members of the Campus Community,

We are writing today to invite your nominations and self-nominations for members to serve on a new Strategic Planning Committee in 2015-16. The committee will work with the whole Connecticut College community during the current academic year to identify the most important goals and priorities for the next five to 10 years. The final result of this Collegewide conversation will be a completed strategic plan in May 2016.

As described in President Bergeron's email last Friday, the 16-person committee will be made up of four faculty members, four staff members, four students, and four members of the senior management team. To help us develop a broadly representative pool of potential candidates, we encourage you to send us nominations. We will work with our respective bodies, with each other, and with the president to determine the final committee membership.

Those selected must be able to serve for the full year. The committee roster will be announced at the end of September so that the committee can begin its work by Oct. 1.
