 - Non-Tax Filer statement - if you were not required to file a 2020 federal tax return, please submit this form
 - If your parent(s) were not required to file a 2020 federal tax return, please submit a Parent Non-Tax Filer Statement.
- Noncustodial Parent’s Profile** – if applicable
- If your parents are divorced, separated, or were never married and are living apart, your noncustodial parent is required to complete the Noncustodial Parent’s PROFILE online if you are applying for institutional need based grant aid. The student can enter the noncustodial email address in their College Board portal and College Board will notify the noncustodial parent they can enter their noncustodial application.
